

This shows how many bedrooms the property has.

You can usually only bid for as many bedrooms as you are assessed as needing (you cannot usually have a 'spare' bedroom for visitors).



This shows the maximum age allowed.

This icon is only used for schemes for young people, for example, where the maximum age would be 25 years old.



This shows the minimum age of the oldest joint homeseeker, for example 55 years old. If one person in a couple is under this age, the couple may not be accepted for the property.



Off-street parking is available at the property.



The property has adaptations for people with limited mobility – please read the individual advert for full details



The property has garden space.
